

Althing January 15, 2005

Regent Kizmit called the Althing to order.

There was no Monarch report, as King Gregor was not present.

Regent Report : The Ithra was currently being conducted with strong attendance and participation.

Crown Qualifications will be held February 12, 2005.

\$400 had been approved at the December Althing for March Coronation feast.

Prime Minister report : Prime Minister Abigail has purchased file boxes and supplies in order to organize the receipts and paperwork in her possession.

Old Business:

Item 1. Section IV.c.ii to be added to the Corpora to read, "Is not required to pay any dues or fees during his/her term." This is in reference to the office of the Champion of the Realm. Princess Kizmit opened the floor for discussion. No one present had any points to discuss. A vote was taken. 10 for and 3 Against.

Item 2. Remove the phrase "Heavy" in the cloth requirement for the Armor Guideline.

Sir Hobbit asked if this meant cloth of all kinds. The answer was "yes". He then asked if this matters for 7.0 rules. The answer again, was "yes". The question was asked if the people present thought this rule change would be abused. Most people present felt it would be. Some more discussion was held on clarification of the current Armor Guidelines. A vote was taken. 0 For and 11 Against.

Princess Kizmit opened the floor for New Business.

It was recommended that the Armor Guidelines for 7.0 rules be reviewed.

Shamus put forth a motion that a position of Kingdom Historian be created. He has details regarding this, and will get that information to King Gregor for the next Althing.

Sir Hobbit made a motion that reads, "Within one month of the end of their term, the outgoing Monarch shall compile a list of all awards, titles and honors and present it to the incoming Monarch(s). The incoming Monarch(s) shall then forward a copy to any/all higher ranking Monarch(s) within the Rising Winds, if applicable.

No further motions were brought forward regarding the next Althing.

Baronet D'Gar made a motion to close the Althing.

Prime Minister Abigail seconded the motion. All present for in favor. Althing Closed.
